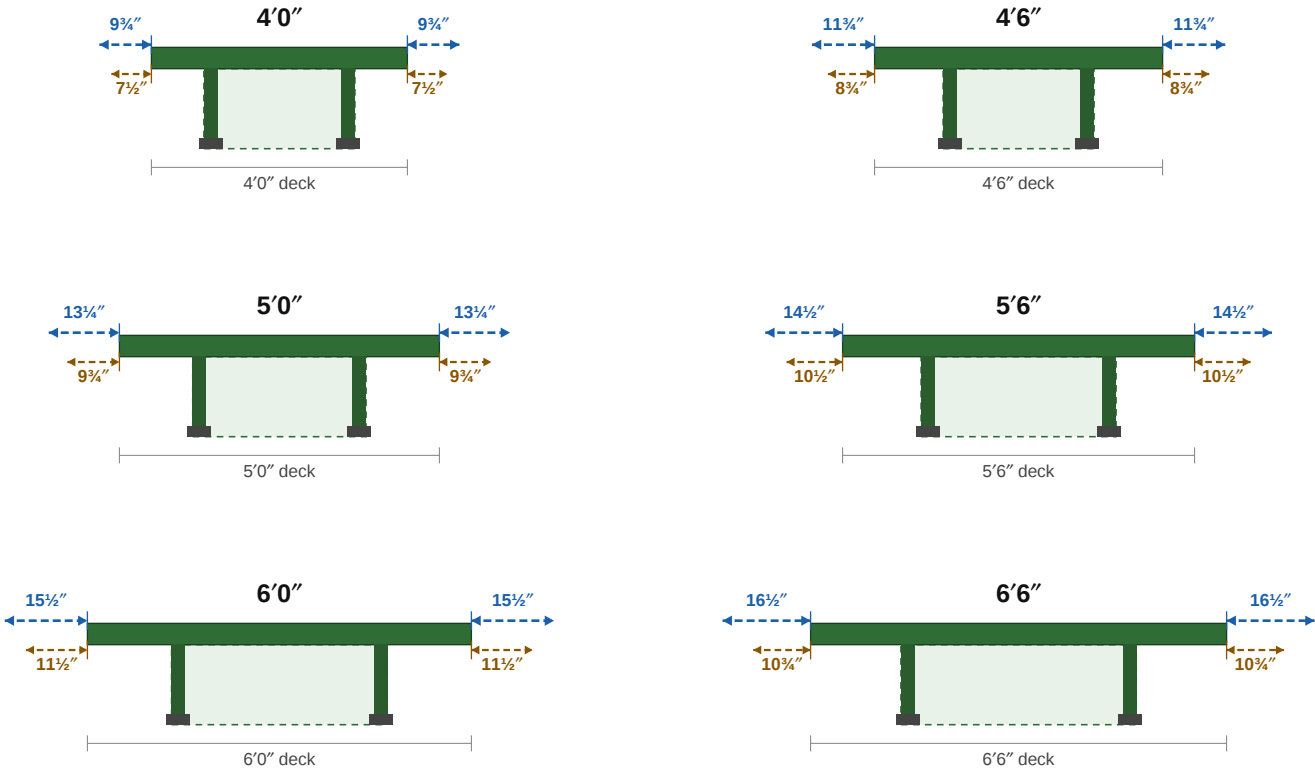


ELEVATION VIEW — BENCH TOP TRAVEL FROM NEUTRAL POSITION

- MAX ROLL
- MR — max travel, legs fixed, no floor track
- STANDARD ROLL
- SR — reduced travel, same fixed-leg system (4'0"–6'6" only)

TRAVEL DISTANCE SUMMARY

Travel is symmetric — equal distance left and right from neutral. Aisle = combined travel of two facing benches both rolled fully open.

HOW IT WORKS

- **Max Roll (MR):** Legs anchored to floor; tabletop slides to either side at maximum available travel. No floor track required.
- **Standard Roll (SR):** Same fixed-leg system as Max Roll but reduced travel distance. Available on all standard widths 4'0"–6'6".
- **Neutral position:** Tabletop centered over leg frame when closed. Wall gaps remain on each side in all positions.
- **Aisle width:** When two adjacent benches each roll outward, the combined travel equals 2× the per-bench roll distance.
